

Malines, 9th September 1808

At the house of his father, Brewer, in Grammont.

My dear Nephew,

I see from your letter of the 5th that you would like to talk to me, and I would also like to see you. Come when you like, as our new Archbishop who should have arrived at the beginning of the week is not yet here and we don't know when he will come, although we don't think it will be long. For the moment the current Archbishop remains here. It could be that I will be visiting in my district when you come but I will try always to be here in the evening.

A thousand greetings to your dear parents, brother and sisters and all the family. I pray for all of them and ask for the help of their prayers.
